

Certificate of Advanced Graduate Study (CAGS) in Administration

Leadership Academy

Application Process and Guidelines

Students who have successfully completed the *Leadership Academy* are eligible to complete the requirements for a Certificate of Advanced Graduate Study (CAGS) in Administration.

Students must complete a simple application process before they may register for CAGS courses.

Note: Students who completed the Leadership Academy **prior to July 2016** must contact the Leadership Academy Director to review the student's official transcript and the current CAGS requirements.*

Here are the steps to apply:

- 1. Candidates need to submit the application found at the end of this document which includes:
 - a) Name and contact information
 - b) Year completed Leadership Academy
 - c) Copy of the candidate's Leadership Academy transcript indicating successful completion of the required 31 credits in the following courses:
 - ADMN 621, 626, 627, 636, 637, 646, 647, 656, 657, 658, 770, 771, 772, 780
 - d) A proposed focus area in the field of educational leadership (this is not binding)
 - e) A written essential question relevant to the area of interest that the candidate would like to explore through the CAGS course work
 - f) Signature from a Leadership Academy Instructor or College Supervisor indicating support of the student's application

Certificate of Advanced Graduate Study (CAGS) Program of Study:

CAGS 902 Seminar II (3 credits)

CAGS 981 Action Research Seminar (3 credits)

CAGS coursework runs from June through August.

Application Deadline: April 15th
